

As of October 17, a total of 487 participants have completed post-event finisher forms.

Based on pre-event registrations, and post-event finisher forms, we estimate 715 participants across the state.

That's 57 mountain bikers, 34 equestrians, and 624 hikers and runners.

Of those who have submitted post-event finisher forms, we've recorded a collective 4,731 miles hiked, run, biked and ridden.

105 people helped shuttle participants for October 6th treks.

As far as we are aware, the youngest person on the trail was 3 months old, and the oldest was 86.

At least 6 people completed a rim-to-rim or a rim-to-rim-to-rim hike through Grand Canyon.

93% of the trail has been completed based on the post-event finishers forms we've received.

There were 5 afterparties in the gateway communities of Sonoita, Summerhaven, Oracle, Superior and Pine.

We sold 236 t-shirts, generating a profit of \$1,932.73.

96% of people that completed a finisher form said they would do it again next year.

There were several folks that were signed up that did not come out on October 6th. Of those, there were 4 sections that lacked coverage as a result. Two out of four (half) of those can be covered with known thru-hikers and thru-bikers in the area.
