



**Name Of Trail Loop:** Historic Cabin Loop

**Passage And location:** Blue Ridge Passage 28; east of Clint's Well

**Length Of Loop Trail:** 16.7

**Loop Trail Description:** See Bruce Grubbs' extensive trail description in either book/source. Generally using Arizona Trail, Fred Haught Trail, Houston Brothers Trail, and Forest Road 300 for the loop.

**Recommended Seasons Of Use:** Spring, Summer, Fall

**Elevation Start:** At northern end 7043'  
At southern end 7264'

**Elevation Gain/Loss:** 2860'

**Access Points:**

The northern access is reached by going 9 miles north of Clint's Well on AZ87. Turn right/east onto FR95 for 11.1 miles. At FR139A turn left/south for 0.1 miles to the Fred Haught Trail crossing.

The southern loop access is gained by turning off AZ 87 and following the Forest Road 300 (Rim Road) east for approximately 11.5 miles to the Battle of Big Dry Wash marker where the Arizona Trail crosses FR 300. Turn left here and drop down to the General Springs Trailhead and the historic General Springs Cabin.
